

2020 Santana 20 Class Championship Regatta
July 15-19, 2020
Ruedi Reservoir, Colorado

The Aspen Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority for this Event

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Bylaws of the Santana 20 Class Association.

Eligibility and Entry

Registered Santana 20 yachts helmed by qualified regular or associate members of the Santana 20 Class Association are eligible to enter the Class Championship Regatta.

Eligible teams may enter using downloaded forms from www.2020ccr.org

Fees

- All skippers are to pay \$300 entry fee to register their boat for the Santana Championship and the AYC annual regatta. The entry fee for the skipper and two (2) crew includes the following:
 - General admission & camping for skipper and two crew.
 - One long sleeve technical shirt from Aspen Yacht Club and three National Championship Regatta T-Shirts
 - Morning continental breakfast Wednesday - Sunday
 - Dinner Wednesday- Saturday
- A \$30 General admission ticket will be charged for all additional crew (over the two included), visitors or shore crew includes the above minus shirts and Saturday night dinner.
 - If crew or visitors want to have the Saturday night dinner it will be an additional \$40.00 per person.

The regular entry period ends June 15, 2020. Registrations after June 15, 2020 will be charged an additional \$50 and additional T-shifts cannot be guaranteed.

Late entries will be accepted after this date subject to limitations discussed under "Fees".

All participants need to be Class members before their qualification regatta.

- *****Campers over 25' are not be allowed on the AYC grounds. There are campsites at the reservoir, but you do need a reservation as soon as possible. They fill up fast in the summer.**
- ***** Dogs are not allowed on the Aspen Yacht Club grounds.**

- Warning signal for first race of the day.

Measurement

All Santana 20 yachts wishing to participate must present a valid Measurement Certificate, have one each of the four required sails measured and stamped; and have the Measurement Checklist completed at the event and prior to the first race.

Boats from Fleets 19 or 28 must be measured and inspected prior to arrival. Other boats will be measured Wednesday morning.

Boats out side of fleets 19/28 intending to participate are required to be measured and should make arrangements with Mike McKeever or Jim Bogner (santana2020nationals@gmail.com).

Sailing Instructions

Official Sailing Instructions will be available at check in.

Venue

Racing will take place on Ruedi Reservoir, Colorado. Camping is provided on the grounds with the general admission per person. Other housing is available (see website for the details)

Courses

The courses be windward-leeward and marks shall be rounded to port. A map of Ruedi Reservoir with approximate locations of marks will be included with the Sailing Instructions. Courses will be posted on the committee boat for each race.

Scoring

Low-point scoring will be used as defined by the RRS except that there will be no discards; DNS, DNF & RET will be scored starters + 1 and DSQ will be scored starters + 2. three completed race will constitute a regatta

Haul-out Restrictions

Boats must remain in the water between the first and last races of the series unless the class measurer approves hauling for repair purposes.

Radio Communication

The RC will use channel 69 to communicate and may attempt to give competitors information concerning starting sequences, schedules and safety. Failure to hear any RC transmission will not be grounds for redress.

Prizes

The winning boat will be awarded the Santana 20 Class Association Class Championship Perpetual Trophy.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Further Information

We will adhere to common Colorado practice of racing with whatever wind appears and not resetting lines and courses or abandoning races to react to small changes in wind direction.

All boats seeking to launch into Ruedi Reservoir will be inspected for invasive species and power washed if necessary. Ruedi is believed to be free of invasive species and boats can be tagged and documented when hauled. Boats arriving on Tuesday & Wednesday will need to get their boats inspected & tagged at the government ramp before heading to the AYC. On Thursday they may come straight to the AYC.
